Coming to Atlanta, GA!

On February 26-27, 2010, John will host a weekend Parenting Retreat in Atlanta, GA. This weekend "re-parenting" experience will be limited to 20 people (comprised of couples and single parents), insuring that each and every "parenting unit" will receive a good amount of personal attention from John.

The retreat schedule will commence on Friday and Saturday's sessions commence at 9:00 am and wrap up at 4:00 on Friday and 3:00 on Saturday. In addition to presenting the workshop content, John will provide plenty of time for questions and discussion of individual parenting issues. John will provide breakfast each morning but the group will break for lunch and be on their own.

In total, every participant or couple will benefit from approximately 13 workshop hours, during which John will present fundamental concepts for establishing functional parenting leadership and disciplinary tools for solving a broad range of problem areas, including classroom issues. Cost for the entire retreat is \$695 per couple or \$349 for a single parent. Lodging and ground transportation are the responsibility of participants, but we will be glad to help folks with their accommodations and make restaurant recommendations. The seminar will be held at the Springhill Suites in Buckhead.
